The World Service Office (WSO) has shipped 208,050 copies of the *Al-Anon Faces Alcoholism 2018* (AFA 2018) second printing magazines to the fellowship. This is an eight percent increase in the number of AFA 2018 second printing copies purchased by members in comparison to the first printing of AFA 2018.

There is still more to celebrate. A total of 400,325 copies of the AFA 2018 magazine issue were ordered by members. This is the first time that the WSO has published more than 400,000 copies of an AFA magazine issue since the outreach project began in 2007.

Congratulations to our fellowship. The willingness of members to distribute information about our program in their communities using the AFA magazine as an outreach tool is gratifying.
