What is Idaho Area 13?

Here is some background on how Al-Anon is organized. WSO stands for World Service Office and is located in Virginia Beach, Virginia.

WSO is made up of areas from around the world. Area 13 includes all of Idaho and surrounding towns such as Clarkston (WA), Ontario (OR) and Afton (WY).

Area 13 consists of seven districts which are shown on a map on the next page. Within each district are groups which hold meetings. In Area 13, over 100 groups hold meetings each week. That's a lot of recovery!

You will not do this alone. Look around you and you will see others who know how you feel. We will love and encourage you no matter what. We ask you to accept us just as we accept you.

Discussing spirituality is never easy, but it is important, especially if you are trying to relate more deeply with the "unseen" parts of life, as we all are. Al-Anon is a spiritual program based on action coming from love. We are sure that as the love grows inside you, you will see beautiful changes in all your relationships, especially with your Higher Power, yourself, and your loved ones. – Sending love and gratitude, Doug C.
