Sue and Randy C. from Spokane, WA. were our facilitators and it was a lot of fun! They took the "terror" out of starting a fourth step inventory with our sponsors. It was interactive and lots of member participated. Some of the over 25 props they had were a life preserver ring, a fire extinguisher, a whisk broom, crown, a mask and handcuffs. Participants shared on what they related to most, such as the mask which they often hid behind when the disease of alcoholism was at its worst in their lives. Sue and Randy had us take a hard look at ourselves in one exercise and another look at negative character traits we perceived the alcoholic in our lives had. It was revealing and clearly showed that we are in this together and that there is nothing to be ashamed of. We have all been there. Members left less fearful of starting the Fourth Step and seemed that they were now looking forward to completing it with their sponsors. Everyone signed a thank you card and on behalf of the District gave them each an Al-Anon book bag as a gift.

Bingo Fundraiser recap: District 1 enjoyed a Saturday night playing Bingo on May 22nd! It was a fun and intentional way to raise \$381 for District 1! Prize Baskets were donated by each group and almost everyone was a winner.
