- Committee Reports:
 - Secretary's Report: Molly
 - Minutes of last meeting
 - Motion to approve - June

 - Treasurer's Report: John H.

 - Line item will be removed from the budget for the Area Reimbursement for storage
 - \$1750 shortfall noted, hopes to receive from group donations to meet budget
 - Please remind all to put group numbers on their checks

- Three-line items for District events with less robust earnings, so may need to offset shortfall
- Distribution of excess funds previously approved: 80% to area, 20% to WSO
- Public Outreach Coordinator: Mary H.
 - In need of a new coordinator to fill this position – please announce at all meetings
 - Any groups or members willing to select some dates at Ashwood Recovery to share your stories?
 - In need of volunteers for Monday evenings and Thursday mornings
 - Need 2 volunteers to share Mon 4/6 at 6 pm and Th 4/9 at 9 AM
- Alateen Coordinator: Kelly
 - Kelly's still trying to connect with prior coordinator to confirm training and certification criteria
 - There are currently 4 active Alateen meetings. All are associated with Boise School District schools.
- DR Report: Mary H.
 - AAISC Meeting report from Saturday's meeting:
 - Board of Trustees (BOT) consists of 6 elected members – currently they have zero and so there is a big need for BOT members. Please share at all meetings that there is this need. BOTs would need to attend monthly meetings via zoom
 - In need of service position volunteers, in addition to BOT elected members, to man the phone and oversee the office. They do have a volunteer coordinator.
 - 1 year of Al-Anon membership is general requirement, additional bookkeeping experience for the treasurer position. They would need to be elected by the GRs.
 - It consists of 5 elected board members to serve staggered terms, all of which need to be filled:
 - Chairperson (2-year term)
 - Vice Chairperson (2-year term)
 - Chairs the fundraising committee and supports the chair
 - Secretary (2-year term)
 - Liaison to the WSC (2-year term)
 - Treasurer (3-year term)
 - 2 signatures required on all checks
 - Beth and LeWayne are the signers on the accounts at this time
 - Member at Large
 - Ex Officio members to the Board of Trustees – have a voice though no vote
 - AAISC Volunteer Coordinator (2-year term)
 - AAISC Literature Coordinator (2-year term)
 - District 3 representative – Mary H attended, will have future invites include both Mary and Lois to try to have representation present though can be anyone representing the district
 - The next AAISC meeting is April 12 at 3pm on zoom
 - Mary will add voting for the service positions to future agendas as volunteers come forward with rotation of service evident the goal
 - AAISC has found they can obtain a printer for \$400.
 - They will have to wait until the district approves a budget to obtain, currently getting by with a black and white printer
 - Please share the budget update with your groups for another month
 - District will plan to vote in April with the lit center rep's quarterly report presentation

- Spiritual Walk report: Mary
 - Set up and board participation was fantastic
 - Attendance was low, 20 attendees
 - All present who participated enjoyed the event and asked for the event to repeat
 - Will need to consider this event as one to break even and not raise funds
- Upcoming event on April 18, 2026: Bringing the Traditions Home
 - Please ask your groups for donations and buy a gift card of your choosing to be included in a raffle
 - Please either bring your gift card to the event or to the next district meeting
 - Please announce at all your meetings
 - Registration is currently down for our current time point
 - Need approx. 70 attendees to break even, currently at 32

7:10-7:25 Literature/Resources Study

- GR responsibilities: To be eligible to fill this position, it requires
 - The candidate is involved in AI-Anon
 - The candidate cannot be a dual member (active member of AA and AI-Anon)
 - Avoids double-headed leadership (*this is also true for the Alt. GR position).
- Copied from the 2026-2029 service manual (p. 61):
 - Acts as liaison between the group and the district and between the group and the Area Assembly (See the Guideline Group Representatives [G-11]).
 - Becomes familiar with the current edition of the AI-Anon/ Alateen Service Manual and encourages its use among group members.
 - Works through the District in helping to initiate public outreach projects.
 - Encourages Alateen sponsorship in accordance with Area Alateen Safety and Behavioral Requirements.
 - Serves as local representative of the appropriate AI-Anon/ Alateen member magazine, The Forum, AI-Anon y Alateen en acción, or Le lien by:
 - Acquainting members with its usefulness.
 - Suggesting personal subscriptions.
 - Submitting group subscriptions to the WSO.
 - Encouraging members to write articles.
 - Is elected for a three-year term.
 - Encourages election of an Alternate GR*.

Group Representative duties, as outlined in the AI-Anon Guidelines, were read and discussed. Many noted that they were not aware of “In the Loop” newsletter. Mary H. will forward the email to everyone that is the latest issue; hopefully it will have a link/instructions for how to subscribe.
