- Taking a Group Inventory
 - Purpose is to keep a group healthy and vital
 - Al-Anon Guidelines on taking a group inventory (G-8a) were shared, read aloud, and a suggestion was made that the guidelines, and some/all of the questions they contain, can be utilized when performing a group inventory.
 - The topic of how best to control time taken by each speaker at a meeting was mentioned as one that is frequently brought up in group inventories.
 - Recommendation was made to make it quick and not drag the process on, and to utilize group inventory to identify, NOT to fix issues.
 - Regina, GR reported their group had members identify which questions/issues they wanted included in their group inventory. Also reports that their Eagle group completes one annually.
 - June, GR noted that their group inventory resulted in changes in how their meetings were formatted.
 - Cathy, GR shared that their group recently completed a group inventory and are currently looking at results.
 - Members then read from guideline G-8b.
 - Mary shared that she is willing to create digital versions of group inventories per the group's desired content to see if people share more. It is confidential and easy to create with survey monkey.
