

Next Steps – June 1, 2026

- **Key Message** – We are not shutting the Literature Center down – we are moving it into District 3
- **Outreach** – District 3 currently has a very active and organized Outreach Committee. I have spoken with Sandy, the coordinator, and she is very willing to discuss adding the Lit Center Outreach activities into her wheelhouse.
 - After Hours phone line
 - Volunteers for 12th Step calls
- **Fund Raisers** – Stop all Lit Center Fund Raisers and let D3 be the primary force for fund raisers. The Lit Center just doesn't have the horsepower to put one on now.
- **Book Sales**
 - Create a new position at District – Literature Coordinator. Keeps groups informed new CAL and help Groups buy from WSO
 - Begin the process of unwinding Lit Center book sales and let Groups buy directly from WSO
 - Develop a plan to deal with current inventory
 - Stop all book purchases
 - Conduct an analysis of the cost difference for Groups buying from WSO as opposed to the Lit Center.
- **Mailboxes** – let each Group maintain their own method of receiving mail
 - Group Mailbox
 - Use GR or Treasurer home address
- **Financial**
 - Determine a reasonable Prudent Reserve and return the remainder to D3
 - Redo the 2026 Budget to reflect these changes
 - Begin to develop a plan for terminating our Lease
- **Website**
 - Enhance the use of the Website as the primary vehicle for people searching for Al-Anon (It gets nearly 3,500 hits per month as opposed to 15 or so calling the Lit Center)
 - Enhance the “Find a Meeting” section to use Cities rather than Districts as primary search engine.
